**Mrs. J. C. Adams Dies at Adams Home Last Night**

Mrs. John C. Adams of Hale, Mo., died at 1:10 o'clock last night at the home of her son, Clinton Adams, six miles northwest of Maryville, following an extended illness of a complication of diseases. She had been at her son's home for the last four weeks. Funeral arrangements have not been completed, but the service will probably be held Friday afternoon.

Mrs. Adams was 60 years old and was born in Christian County, Ill. Until three years ago when the family moved to Hale, Mo., Mrs. Adams lived in the vicinity of Wilcox for eight years. Surviving are her husband and nine children. They are Mrs. R. Lela Bilyeu, Moweaqua, Ill.; Martin Adams, Hale, Mo.; Clinton Adams, living northwest of Maryville; Joseph R.
