

Miss Lida Onstott Dies in Washington

Body to Be Brought Here and Funeral

Held December 26. Born Near

Maryville.

Perry Onstot, near Ravenwood, received a message yesterday afternoon announcing the death of his sister, Miss Lida Belle Onstot, at a clinic Tuesday morning at a hospital in Sumner, Wash. Miss Onstot had been ill less than a week of influenza and pneumonia.

The body will arrive on the Burlington Saturday evening, and the funeral will be held Monday, December 26. Other funeral arrangements have not been completed.

Miss Onstot had been visiting her brothers, Ed Onstot of Sumner and Hugh Onstot of Walla Walla, Wash., since last January. She was born November 9, 1882, on the Onstot farm, five miles northwest of Maryville, and had lived in Nodaway county all of her life.

Four other brothers survive, as follows: Floyd Onstot, Hinckney, Minn.; Robert Onstot, Arlington, Neb.; Charles Onstot, Cheyenne, Wyo.; and Jesse Onstot, Kansas City.
